

How many fiber optic cables are needed for two switches



Overview

To connect multiple Ethernet switches, the best way is to use a multi-strand fiber cable. The 4-strand pre-terminated fiber optic cable consists of four individual strands or fibers of glass or plastic fibers enclosed in a protective sheath.
