

How to connect two pigtails from one pigtail



Overview

This is accomplished by splicing the incoming hot wire (usually black) together with two short black pigtails using a wire nut. Each of these two pigtails then connects to one brass-colored terminal screw on the two individual switches, supplying continuous power to both devices. Two of the switches (fan and light) both have two black wires attached to one screw, which I have read is both wrong and dangerous. To correct this, can I use a 3 slot Wago connector for the two existing wires, along with a new pigtail wire to be connected to the switch?
