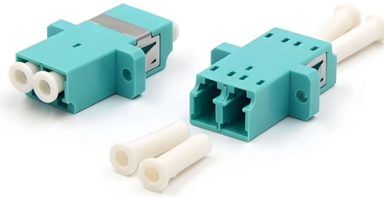


Optical Cable Line Protection Measures
