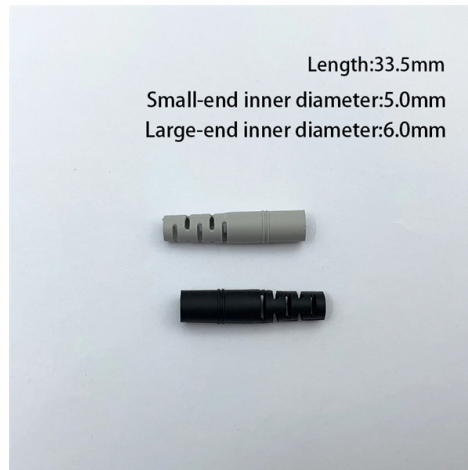


Removal of wall with electrical distribution box
