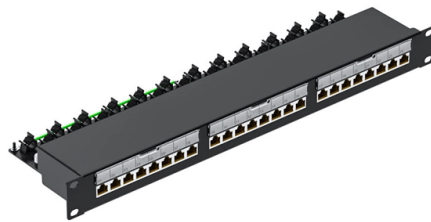


The circuit breaker tripped at the socket in the distribution box
